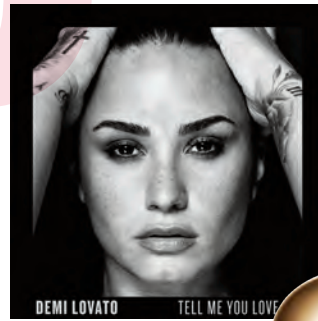


From David Fincher, aka the brain behind *House of Cards*, comes Netflix's equally addictive—and twisted—**Mindhunter** (Oct. 13).
